

SUMMER'S HERE so it's time to dust off the barbeque, put on your apron and have a party with family and friends. These are a couple of delicious barbecue recipes that are sure to be a hit.

Tangerine Adobo Chicken *(Jay's and Larry's favorite)*

INGREDIENTS:

- 4 cups Orange Tangerine Juice
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon Maggi Seasoning Sauce
- 2 tablespoons chipotle chiles in adobo sauce from a can, chopped
- 8 chicken thighs (bone-in)

DIRECTIONS:

- 1 Heat juice and sugar in a large saucepan; whisk until sugar is completely dissolved. Whisk in seasoning sauce and chiles; cook for 3 to 4 minutes. Do not boil. Remove from heat; let cool.
- 2 Place chicken thighs in a large freezer bag; carefully pour in Juice mixture. Seal; refrigerate for 12 hours.
- 3 Preheat grill or broiler.
- 4 Grill or broil chicken for about 7 minutes on each side or until no longer pink in center. To test, pierce a thigh with a knife and if juice is clear, the thighs are cooked.



Grilled Shrimp Tacos with Charred Corn Salsa

INGREDIENTS:

For the shrimp marinade:

- 1 lb shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 1/2 lemon, zested and juiced
- 2 Tablespoons olive oil
- 1 Tablespoon fresh oregano, chopped
- 1/4 teaspoon each salt and pepper

For the salsa:


- 1/2 sweet onion
- 1 corn cob, steamed or boiled
- 1/2 cup chopped tomatoes
- 1/4 cup chopped cilantro
- 1 jalapeno, seeded and chopped
- 1 lime, juiced
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 Tablespoons olive oil

For the tacos:

- 12 soft corn tortillas
- 1 avocado diced
- 2 Tablespoons fresh cilantro
- 1/4 cup feta cheese, crumbled (optional)

DIRECTIONS:


- 1 In a bowl, combine shrimp, lemon juice and zest, olive oil, fresh oregano, salt and pepper. Let marinate while you prepare the salsa.
- 2 Preheat grill to 400F. Cut onion in to four wedges and toss with olive oil. Brush a little olive oil on the corn. Grill onion and corn for about 10 minutes or until slightly charred and the onion is soft.
- 3 Remove from heat and place on a cutting board. Cut kernels off the corn and roughly chop grilled onion.
- 4 In a medium bowl, combine corn, onion, tomatoes, cilantro, jalapeno, lime, salt and 1 Tablespoon olive oil. Stir until well combined. Set aside to marinate while you grill the shrimp.
- 5 Lightly grill the corn tortillas on each side, then wrap them in a clean tea towel to keep warm. Place a grill basket over the heat, and add the shrimp. Quickly grill them, turning once, about 2 minutes per side or until they are bright pink.
- 6 To assemble: Serve warm tortillas, grilled shrimp, corn salsa, avocado, feta cheese and cilantro garnish and assemble tacos at the table.
